Brief History of the Faculty

The faculty of Law and Political Sciences at Badji Mokhtar Annaba University is one of the most prestigious faculties. It was established in 1975 and it was known as the Institute of Legal and Administrative Sciences. Later, it came to be called the Faculty of Law. However, In the line with the new system of L.M.D and the field of training (D.S.P) and pursuant to the executive decree No. 84-2014 dated on august 18th 1984, it came to be officially called the Faculty of Law and Political Science.

By the adoption of new system of training L.M.D, the faculty had known different changes and developments through several offers of training and specialties at both the first cycle (License) and second cycle (Master). In this respect, new departments were created which are the Department of Public Law, Private Law and the Department Political Sciences in addition to the post graduation training which includes Magister, Doctorate School and Doctorate 3rd Cycle.

In terms of infrastructure, the faculty has numerous administrative and pedagogical infrastructures in addition to qualified human resources. It produces periodically significant researches through its Labs and research projects.
