Presentation of the faculty

In the line with the new system of L.M.D and the field of training (D.S.P) and pursuant to the executive decree No. 84-2014 dated on august 18th 1984, it came to be officially called the Faculty of Law and Political Science.

By the adoption of new system of training L.M.D, the faculty had known different changes and developments through several offers of training and specialties at both the first cycle (License) and second cycle (Master). Moreover, new departments were created which are the Department of Public Law, Private Law and the Department Political Sciences in addition to the post graduation training which includes Magister, Doctorate School and Doctorate 3rd Cycle.
